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### **Minutes:**

- 1. Welcome and information from chair (KTJ)
  - a. Update on the corona-situation KTJ asks students to comment
    - i. SS: I have been granted access to the lab. Overall is happy to be able to run experiments. Things have been slowed down.
  - b. KTJ informs that there is no deadline for applying for extensions due to corona, but it needs to be substantiated
  - c. MB: Generally conferences are cancelled also the rest of the year. May be an issue for the PhD students.
  - d. BAL: PhD defense many attendees to zoom meetings. Could be relevant also in the future to enable people from abroad to join virtually.
